YOUTH OPTIONS PROGRAM

The Youth Options Program is an opportunity for qualified Wisconsin public high school students to participate in courses offered at the University of Wisconsin Fox Valley. High school students must be in the upper 25% of their graduating class to be considered for admission.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

- UW System application
- Completed Youth Options worksheet/permission form
- Official High School transcript
- DPI 8700 form

All information must be submitted every semester with the exception of the UW application for continuing students.

Application Process

When the file is complete, the student will receive a letter of confirmation and information on policies and regulations from the assistant campus dean-student services.

Fee and Billing Process

High Schools will be billed for all Youth Options students during the fifth week of each semester. The invoice will be accompanied by a copy of the students' class schedule.

Withdrawals

School districts will be billed a \$100 withdrawal fee if a student withdraws any time between registration and the second week of classes.

Withdrawal or drop after second week of classes will require payment of 50% of class fees.

Withdrawal or drop after fourth week of classes will require payment of 100% of class fees.

Students must talk to the HS counselor if they need to drop/withdraw. Non-attendance does not constitute withdrawal.

Grades

UW Fox Valley does not mail grades. Students will be assigned a PRISM (student record system) account, with which they can check grades, etc. Grading policies can be found on pages 33-36 of our catalog. Online at <http://www.uwc.edu/academics/catalog.asp>
