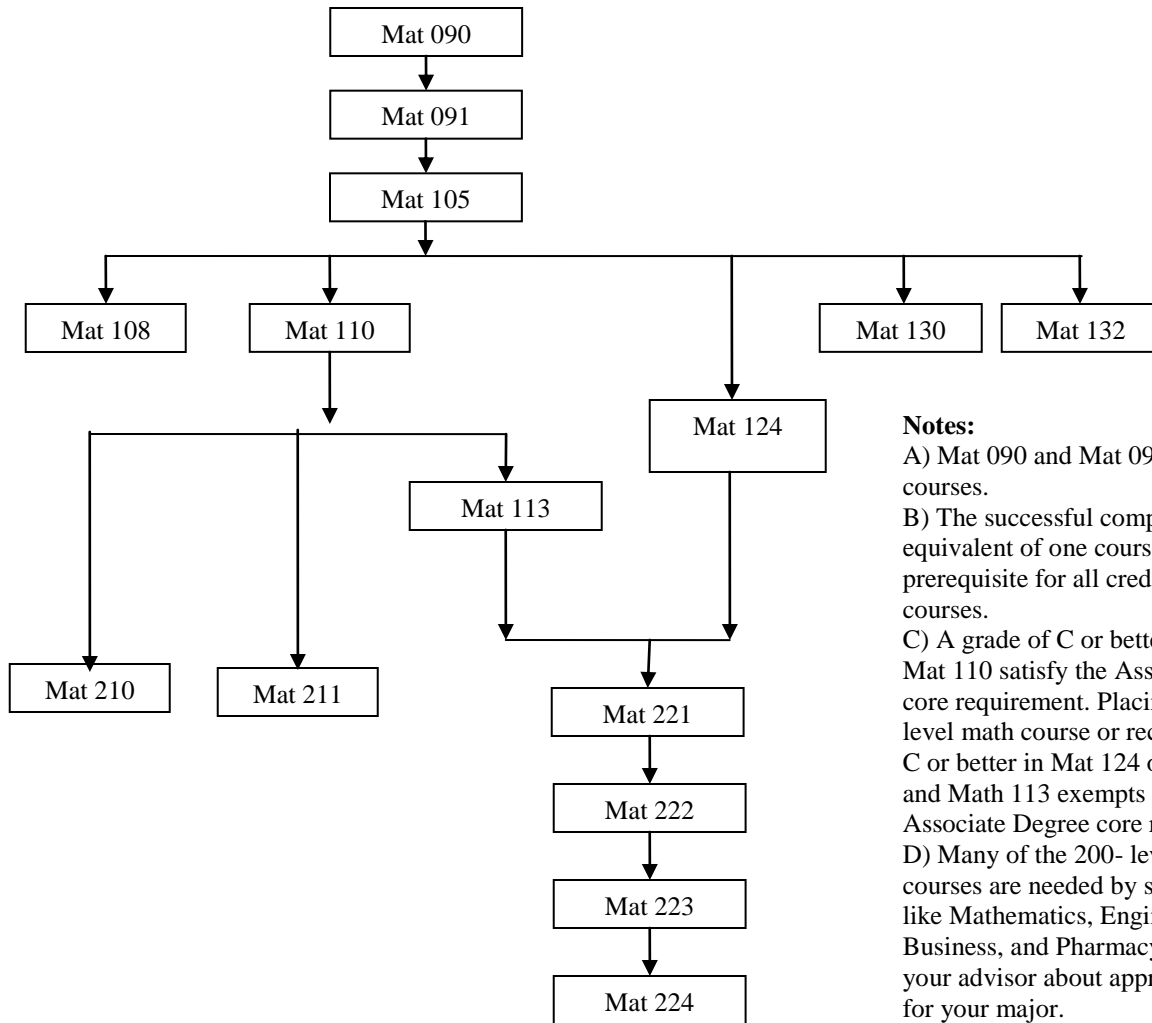


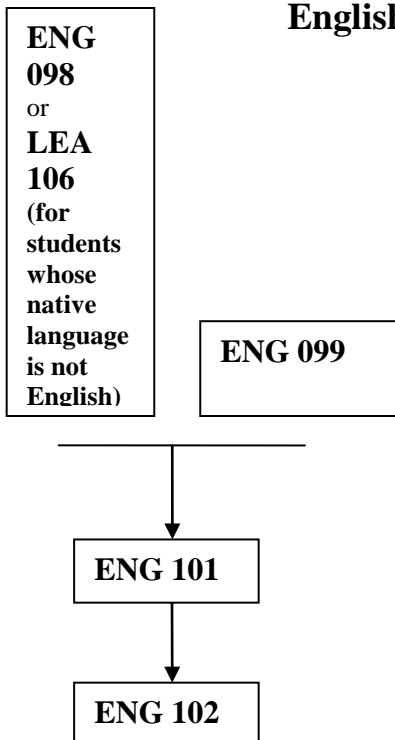
Math Placement Test Interpretation



Notes:

- A) Mat 090 and Mat 091 are non-degree courses.
- B) The successful completion of the equivalent of one course in geometry is a prerequisite for all credit mathematics courses.
- C) A grade of C or better in Mat 108 and Mat 110 satisfy the Associate Degree core requirement. Placing into a 200 level math course or receiving a grade of C or better in Mat 124 or both Math 110 and Math 113 exempts you from the Associate Degree core requirement.
- D) Many of the 200- level mathematics courses are needed by specific majors like Mathematics, Engineering, Business, and Pharmacy. Please talk to your advisor about appropriate classes for your major.

Notes

- A) ENG 098, ENG 099 and LEA 106 are non-degree courses.
- B) Students who place into ENG 098 may take LEA 106 instead.
- C) Students who place into ENG 098 are required to take ENG 099.
- D) Students who test into ENG 101 may also benefit from ENG 099. ENG 099 may be repeated in subsequent semesters.
- E) A grade of C or better in Eng 102 satisfies the Associate Degree core requirement.
- F) UW Colleges English Department strongly recommends that all students take ENG 102. However, if a student wishes to be exempted from ENG 102 for the Associate of Arts and Science Degree, he or she must have a certain combined score on the writing and reading placement tests to be eligible, and students must submit a portfolio of work to be considered for exemption.
