

You must use a computer in one of the campus computer labs or some other computer that has Scientific Notebook installed on it in order to view Scientific Notebook-based quizzes or exercises.

There are two or three ways a UW Colleges student may obtain a copy of that software for use on a home computer.

- From **MacKichan Software, Inc.**, you may download a copy of the software to use free for a month--or for one year after registering it.
- Present your student ID at the campus helpdesk to receive the software on your USB drive or memory stick.
- *If your instructor has offered* to loan you a CD copy, be sure to return it after installing the software.

Before you install the software, you should review the installation/registration instructions found at **SN Setup** on the UWC IT Resources web pages. Follow them carefully. It's important to use a particular serial number and your UWC email address when registering.

Within a day or two of registering Scientific Notebook you will receive an email from the UWC SciNotebook Administrator, and that will instruct you how to install the *license* for the software.

To see whether you have completed those tasks correctly, use the **SN License Test** which will open a test file in Scientific Notebook. If the test indicates a problem, review your email message and try the licensing step once more. If you don't succeed, return to the registration instructions from UWC IT Resources and register again. The Help menu contains the command to register the software. There is no reason to install the software a second time. Don't give up!

If you are going to be working with Scientific Notebook exercises online, as opposed to printing them out, you should use the **Get Some Practice** link for an exercise that will familiarize you with some of the capabilities.

Whenever you print a Scientific Notebook quiz or exercise, be sure to Print Preview first to determine the number of pages that need to be printed. Usually the quiz questions are followed by several more blank pages. You are charged for pages printed on campus, and there is no refund when you print blank pages.
