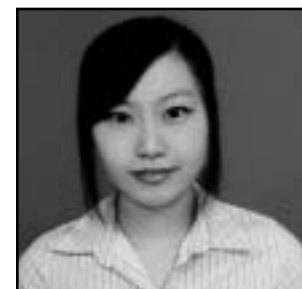
Nguyen Le, 18, from Vietnam
